PASTORAL CARE TEAM FLOURISHING

Last fall, we invited parishioners interested in visiting the: sick, elderly, or homebound, to join the Pastoral Care Team. The response has been overwhelmingly positive. Our parish now has a team of **32 people** mobilized to visit the **8** residences and assisted living facilities in our area. Teams of 2-4 people bring Holy Communion to parishioners unable to physically join us on the weekend on a bi-weekly basis. Each residence now has members of the team who lead Liturgy of the Word Services with Communion, and do personal room visits. The level of care our elderly and homebound parishioners now receive may be the best in the Archdiocese. A big thank you to the members of our Pastoral Care Team for their: generosity of time, loving care, and dedication to this important ministry.
