Summary Notes from 2022:

- 1. Most regular parishioners have now transitioned from envelopes/cash to automated electronic (or online CanadaHelps.org) giving to the parish
- 2. School-aged sacraments have returned to being in-person in 2022.
- *The parish helped several families in need at: Easter, Christmas, and after the derecho storm on May 21st 2022
- 3. In 2020, staff were off during lockdowns, so Salaries Expense is under-represented when comparing year-to-year figures.
- 4. Some parishioners offered to pay for some of our maintance expenses in 2022.
- *All interior (church & hall), and bell tower lights were upgraded to LED (Paid for by a parish family)
- 5. The parish rectory renovations have been completed, and is fully rented out to tenants, as of January 2023.

Thanks to the very generous donation of one family, the rectory restoration was at no financial cost to the parish.

6. As of March 2020, the Finance Council decided to only pay mortgage interest until revenues became more stable after the pandemic.

Summary Notes from 2022:

- 1. Funds from Special Collections, are held in short-term investments with the Archdiocese at 3.5% until disbursed.
- 2. \$24k was received to sponsor a refugee. This is an 'In-Trust' sponsorship administered through the Archdiocese.
- 3. We received donations to help with the cost of connection of Municipal Services, and in support of the Alpha Program.

As development of the surrounding area progresses, the church facilities will have to be connected to city water & sewer.

The expected cost for: city water, sewer connections, and the decommissioning of our septic field will be approximately \$300k.
